57 children displaced by genocide have participated in the STLFWM sponsorship program since 2006. Over these years, 7 sponsored children were rediscovered and reunited with family members. Others completed their education and are now living independently. As part of the spiritual formation provided by the Sisters, nearly every child has been baptized. Today, 29 children remain in the program and are working to complete their education: 1 attends college, 7 attend vocational training, 19 attend secondary school, 1 attends primary school, and 1 is a special needs student. By partnering with the Sisters of St. Therese of the Child Jesus, your donations have provided stability, education and opportunities for children to attain self-sufficient lives. 2016-2017 Divine Mercy Girls Seminary in Tanzania Update

The Sisters of the Child Jesus opened Divine Mercy Girls Seminary in 2014. The school provides a quality secondary education in a safe environment, spiritual formation and boarding for 175 young women. 500 students are expected to attend by the year 2022. There is immediate need of financial support for:

- 1. **Construction of adequate bathrooms and septic tanks** The current plumbing is inadequate. This puts students at risk for cholera. Total cost: \$29,500
- **2. Construction of a well with reservoirs** The current water supply is inadequate. This requires traveling long unsafe distances to get water. Total cost: **\$52,000**
