Divine Mercy Girls Seminary in Tanzania Update

The Sisters opened DMGS in 2014. The school provides a quality secondary school education including spiritual formation and safe boarding for 175 girls. DMGS students are free to discern either a religious or non-religious vocation. Our ongoing capital campaign to fund the construction of bathrooms, septic tanks, a water well and perimeter wall continues. We plan to begin construction in 2019.

Sponsors Needed at Divine Mercy Girls Seminary

We recently launched a student sponsorship program to help cover the cost of tuition and boarding at DMGS. Most girls come from impoverished families. Accessibility to secondary schools is most difficult for girls because of distance, lack of boarding and safety concerns. Several students are hoping someone will sponsor them for the upcoming school year.
