DMGS, founded in 2014, provides a Catholic secondary school education with boarding for 175 girls. The DMGS Student Sponsorship Program helps cover the cost of tuition and boarding. Many DMGS students come from impoverished families in need of financial assistance. Please prayerfully consider supporting a student in need for the upcoming school year. DMGS graduates are offered continued financial support from this sponsorship program through high school and college.

### **Capital Campaign Update**

Construction of the perimeter wall for DMGS was completed in October of 2022. The entire compound is safely enclosed by a ten foot stone wall including three entrance gates with guard stations. The new wall provides protection for the students and faculty. The cost of the wall totaled \$110,000. Thank you for your generous support!

The current dorm at DMGS has deteriorated beyond repair and needs to be torn down. The new dorm will cost \$1,048,550. We currently have a matching gift offer for this project. Please consider a donation toward the construction of this much needed dorm. Keep in mind, your donation will be matched.
